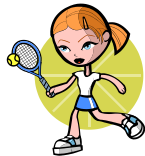

VEOLIA MULWAREE TRUST

The Veolia Environmental Trust supports community projects and charities for the benefit of the community of former Mulwaree Shire Council area in Southern NSW or a community within a council area which immediately adjoined Mulwaree. Trust funds are generated from Veolia's Woodlawn Bioreactor near Tarago. In the past four years the Veolia Mulwaree Trust has proudly contributed more than \$2.7 million toward community projects supporting hospitals, schools, charities, sport and recreation facilities and community groups.

The Veolia Mulwaree Trust has assisted 34 local not-for-profit organisations in its February 2011 funding round by providing more than \$150,000 in grants and donations. This brings the total distributed by the Trust to more than \$4 million over the past six years.

Local projects to be funded include: Milton Ulladulla Tennis Assoc. for the construction of a concrete pathway to improve access to three courts and drainage at the complex with a grant of \$6320.
